

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ

The **month of May** is a special time to pay homage to our **Blessed Mother Mary**. She has a unique role in salvation history as the Mother of God, conceived without Sin, who by her own free will agreed to bring the “Word made flesh”, (John 1:14) our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ into the world. Paul VI wrote a short encyclical in 1965 using the Month of Mary devotion as a means of obtaining prayers for peace. He wrote that May is a time in which *“the Blessed Virgin Mary is honored and the Christian people are enriched with spiritual gifts.”*

The Easter prayer Regina Coeli (“Queen of Heaven”) is a wonderful tribute to our Lord’s resurrection and to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Regina Coeli is an antiphon (short liturgical texts sung or chanted) dedicated to Our Lady. Traditionally, it is prayed standing, often at noon, in place of another well-known prayer, the Angelus, during the Easter Season from Holy Saturday until Pentecost.

Queen of Heaven, rejoice. Alleluia.

For He, whom thou wast worthy to bear. Alleluia.

Has risen as He said. Alleluia.

Pray for us to God. Alleluia.

V. Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary. Alleluia.

R. Because the Lord is truly risen, Alleluia.

Let us pray, O God, Who by the Resurrection of Thy Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, hast been pleased to give joy to the whole world, grant we beseech Thee, that through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, His Mother, we may attain the joys of eternal life. Through the same Christ, our Lord. Amen.
