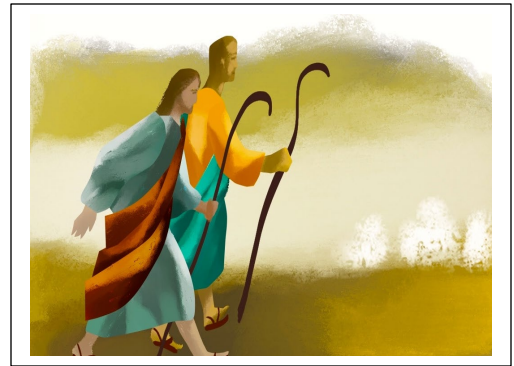

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ

This week's Gospel and the one for next week describe how Jesus sent the disciples to minister in his name. Mark's Gospel tells us that Jesus sent out the Twelve. Mark notes that these twelve are also called "apostles." The word apostle means "one who is sent."

Jesus sends them in pairs, and instructs them to travel lightly, without the customary food, money, and extra set of clothes. These instructions mean that the Twelve will be dependent on the hospitality of others, just as Jesus depended on others to provide for his needs. Jesus continues to send us into the world as his disciples. But like the first disciples, we are not sent alone. Jesus has given us the community of the Church, which strengthens our life of discipleship. The Christian message can only authentically be proclaimed in and through the community of faith that is the Church. In our work with others, we build this community of faith and can invite others to share in it.

On Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> October, we will have our first ever Leadership Summit. The theme of the morning will be "*parish leadership: equipping ministry for mission & service*". Guided by the work of the Divine Renovation Network ([www.divinerenovation.org](http://www.divinerenovation.org)) I will be inviting parishioners with leadership and co-ordination responsibilities to come together to pray and discuss our mission of sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ, through loving service and joyful worship. We are called at this time to make our Parish Vision Statement such as reality that we will find renewed commitment to growing and making disciples of Jesus Christ.

May we live the Good News with joy.

Thank you to everyone who responded to the **Post Covid Questionnaire**. We had 79 replies and approximately 40% said they would prefer to attend with social distancing measure still in the church after the lifting of government restrictions. Others replied that they would be happy to attend without prebooking for masses, and the requirement of wearing masks and social distancing in the pews. It is proposed that post lifting of government restrictions on the 19<sup>th</sup> July we will have half of our churches still reserved for those who prefer to attend mass with social distancing measures. This will be in place in our churches for the time being and will be reviewed before the end of August. Further details will be announced as they become available.
