#### Dear brothers and sisters in Christ

It is on Palm Sunday that we enter Holy Week, welcoming Jesus into our lives and asking Him to allow us a share in His suffering, death and Resurrection. This is the time of the year when we stop to remember and relive the events which brought about our redemption and salvation.

Despite the adaptions of the liturgies in response to COVID 19, Holy Week enables us to experience in our lives here and now what Jesus went through then. In other words, what we commemorate and relive during this week is not just Jesus' dying and rising, but our own dying and rising in Him, which results in our healing, reconciliation, and redemption. Participation in the Holy Week liturgies will also deepen our relationship with God, increase our Faith and strengthen our lives as disciples of Jesus.

Palm Sunday recalls the welcome of Jesus into Jerusalem and the drama of His trial which ends in His crucifixion and death. Let us rejoice and sing as Jesus comes into our lives. Let us also weep and mourn as His death conquers. The African-American song asks the question, "Were you there when they crucified my Lord? Were you there when they nailed Him to a tree?" The liturgy of the Church warns that we can be in the crowd on both days, shouting, "Hosanna!" and later "Crucify Him!"

Christianity is not a faith of purely historical interest, for we live in the 'eternal now' of God and Christ's life death and resurrection is a personal gift, for we we can only accept with faith and gratitude.

I thank God for your faithfulness.
