This weekend we welcome **Br John McAllister s.m.** who will be giving an appeal on behalf of the **Society of Mary (Marist Fathers)** in Oceania, South Asia, Africa and South America, who work with refugees, street children, in education, and in pastoral care, for which there will be a retiring collection.

Last Sunday **Bishop Richard Moth** wrote in his pastoral letter of the **16th Synod of Bishops**, taking place in Rome in 2023. This week Pope Francis will inaugurate the preparation for the synod. The theme of the Synod is "*Communion, Participation and Mission*". The Holy Father is asking diocese and parishes to reflect on how we can effectively proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ. The diocese is putting together resources for reflection during Advent which we will make available to use in groups discussion on-line at home.

We are asked to pray an invocation to the Holy Spirit "Adsumus, Sancte Spiritus" Every session of the Second Vatican Council began with the prayer Adsumus Sancte Spiritus, the first word of the Latin original meaning, "We stand before You, Holy Spirit" As we are called to embrace this synodal path of the Synod 2021-2023, this prayer invites the Holy Spirit to operate within us so that we may be a community and a people of grace.

We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name.

With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts;

Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it.

We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder.

Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions.

Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life

and not stray from the way of truth and what is right.

All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time,
in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.
