

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ

The Easter Sunday we begin the Easter Season, our 50-day meditation on the mystery of Christ's Resurrection. Our Gospel today tells us about the disciples' discovery of the empty tomb. It concludes by telling us that they did not yet understand that Jesus had risen from the dead. In the weeks ahead, the Gospel readings from our liturgy will show us how the disciples came to believe in Jesus' Resurrection through his appearances to them. Our Easter faith is based on their witness to both the empty tomb and their continuing relationship with Jesus—in his appearances and in his gift of the Holy Spirit.

At the Easter Sunday mass we renew our baptismal promises. The meaning of baptism is to pass through the water of death and rise to new life, and to become one with God and one with Jesus, bound together in the Spirit. And so now we will, once again, take those vows that our godparents took for us many years ago. And we will rise up, and we will take these same words and say to God, "Yes, I do." Through our baptism we journey towards and with Christ. This journey involves acceptance of the Gospel, conversion, profession of faith, the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, Eucharistic communion and the grace of the sacraments

The church gathers this Sunday to renew the promises of baptism and we will say with a full heart, "I do" so that we seek to grow in our response to God's love for us.

My best wishes to you all for this season of Easter.
