This week has marked the tenth anniversary of the visit of Pope Benedict XXI to the United Kingdom from the 16<sup>th</sup> to the 19<sup>th</sup> September. The Holy Father flew firstly to Scotland where he was received by Her Majesty the Queen. Later he celebrated a public Mass at Bellahouston Park in Glasgow. In England, amongst other things, His Holiness made a speech to British civil society at Westminster Hall, met with the leaders of other Christian traditions, took part in a service of Evening Prayer with the Archbishop of Canterbury, led a prayer vigil, met with leaders and people of other faiths and beatified the nineteenth century theologian and educationalist Blessed John Henry Newman

One was the drive down the great road approaching Buckingham Palace – The Mall – decorated on either side with papal flags and Union Jacks. Packed with people on both sides. I remember saying to the Holy Father, “we’re going to Hyde Park and we’re going to use the platform, the stage, which a week before was used for The Proms, for the music.” So I said, “tonight, it’s not music, but it’s prayer.” And he said to me, “music is prayer, you know – music is prayer too.” And it was that kind of breadth of his understanding of the human spirit that whenever we are moved by music, then we’re moved towards God.”*

**October's Communal First Saturday devotions** on the 3<sup>rd</sup> October will be a little different, as Fr. Paul will be celebrating the sacrament of First Holy Communion for our young parishioners on that day. Therefore, we will not be having confessions or mass as usual.

However, we will have the First Saturday Devotions at St. Tarcisius beginning at 9am with: Adoration, Opening Prayers, Rosary, and an opportunity to offer a perfect Act of Contrition and an opportunity to make a Spiritual Communion. We will finish with 15 minute meditation. Fr Paul will be hearing confession at St Tarcisius on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> October before the morning mass from 8.30am.

All 4 practices are encouraged in order to help to fulfil our Lady of Fatima's request, that on the First Saturday of the month we go to confession, pray the rosary, receive Holy Communion,

and meditate on the mysteries of the Rosary, all with intention of making reparation to her Immaculate Heart.

### Sunday Mass Arrangements

- We encourage you to **register for seating via Eventbrite** for Sunday Mass via the parish website. We cannot guarantee places for those who arrive without booking.
- It is necessary that we have an accurate record of the name and contact details of those attending Mass in case requested **by NHS Test & Trace** to provide a contact list
- Arriving at church for Sunday Mass without first reserving a seat will require additional time for your name and contact details to be manually recorded
- There is **hand sanitisation** at entry.
- The **entrances and exits** all have protocols to meet social distancing measures.
- The **stewards** will guide you to your seats and seating has been designed to embrace social distancing measures.
- **Holy communion** will be distributed at all Sunday Masses after the blessing!
- The stewards will guide you out pew by pew to receive Communion.
- Please keep your masks on as you process to Holy Communion and adjust it so to receive the Sacred Host after Fr Paul has administered it on the hand
