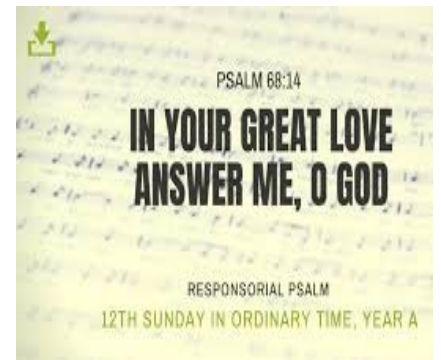

\*Please note that St Tarcisius Church will not be open for private prayer *this* Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June because we need more time to prepare the church and complete the health and safety documents.

I am grateful for the considerable work that Sandie, in the Parish office has done to make this possible, for those who have cleaned and prepared our churches and those who have volunteered to be stewards. The current guidelines for self-distancing will be strictly respected. Unfortunately, we will not be able to offer toilet facilities.

Our Lord says in this Sunday's gospel *"Do not be afraid. For everything that is now covered will be uncovered, and everything now hidden will be made clear. What is said to you in the dark, tell it in the daylight, what you hear in whispers, proclaim it from the housetops"* This last few months have been very difficult for everyone especially those who have suffered illness and the death of a loved one. It has felt like the practice of our faith has been 'covered' whilst our churches have been closed for prayer and public worship. Yet the Lord has not been silent. He has been calling each one of us to deepen our love for him and to allow his grace to rule in our lives. May we know what it means to be *"disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ."* May our churches be places of prayer and hospitality for those who are seeking the Lord.

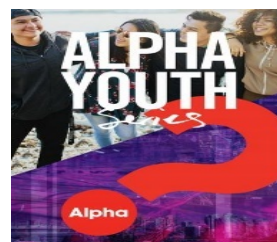
