

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ

I will be away on holiday after the Sunday Masses until Tuesday 15th September. I am grateful that Fr Kieran Gardiner will be supplying for me while I am away.

I pray that more people will be able to gather to worship the Lord over the next few months. However, we will still need to use the internet to enable us to worship together. The Lord says in this Sunday's gospel. *"In truth I tell you once again, if two of you on earth agree to ask anything at all, it will be granted to you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three meet in my name, I am there among them."* Let us pray that we will be able to gather freely and fully for worship and that when we do our hearts will have grown on live for Jesus Christ our saviour.

We are broadcasting from St Peter and St John Church and using zoom for many of our parish meetings. However, it has proved challenging to get a reliable signal at St Tarcisius church. When we can overcome these problems, we will also look at having live broadcast at Christ the King. However, I do know that we have learnt a lot about how to use social media for communication and worship. I would just ask you to respond to two initiatives that are coming up;

- The **online Alpha course** starting on 17th September. It is an ideal course for both church goers and the "unchurched" to come to grow or become disciples of Jesus Christ. Please invite family members and friends to join you for on-line Alpha and sign up on the link published in this newsletter.
- We are planning again to use YouTube for **"children's liturgy"**. It is a great way for families with young to gather in prayer, at home, led by our parish catechists. To help us plan resources for family worship we have set up a "Children's Liturgy Survey." Please contact the parish office for a copy.

Sunday Mass Arrangements

- We encourage you to **register for seating via Eventbrite** for Sunday Mass. We cannot guarantee places for those who arrive without booking.
- It is necessary that we have an accurate record of the name and contact details of those attending Mass in case requested **by NHS Test & Trace** to provide a contact list
- Arriving at church for Sunday Mass without first reserving a seat will require additional time for your name and contact details to be manually recorded
- There is **hand sanitisation** at entry.
- The **entrances and exits** all have protocols to meet social distancing measures.
- The **stewards** will guide you to your seats and seating has been designed to embrace social distancing measures.
- **Holy communion** will be distributed at all Sunday Masses after the blessing!
- The stewards will guide you out pew by pew to receive Communion.
- Please keep your masks on as you process to Holy Communion and adjust it so to receive the Sacred Host after Fr Paul has administered it on the hand
